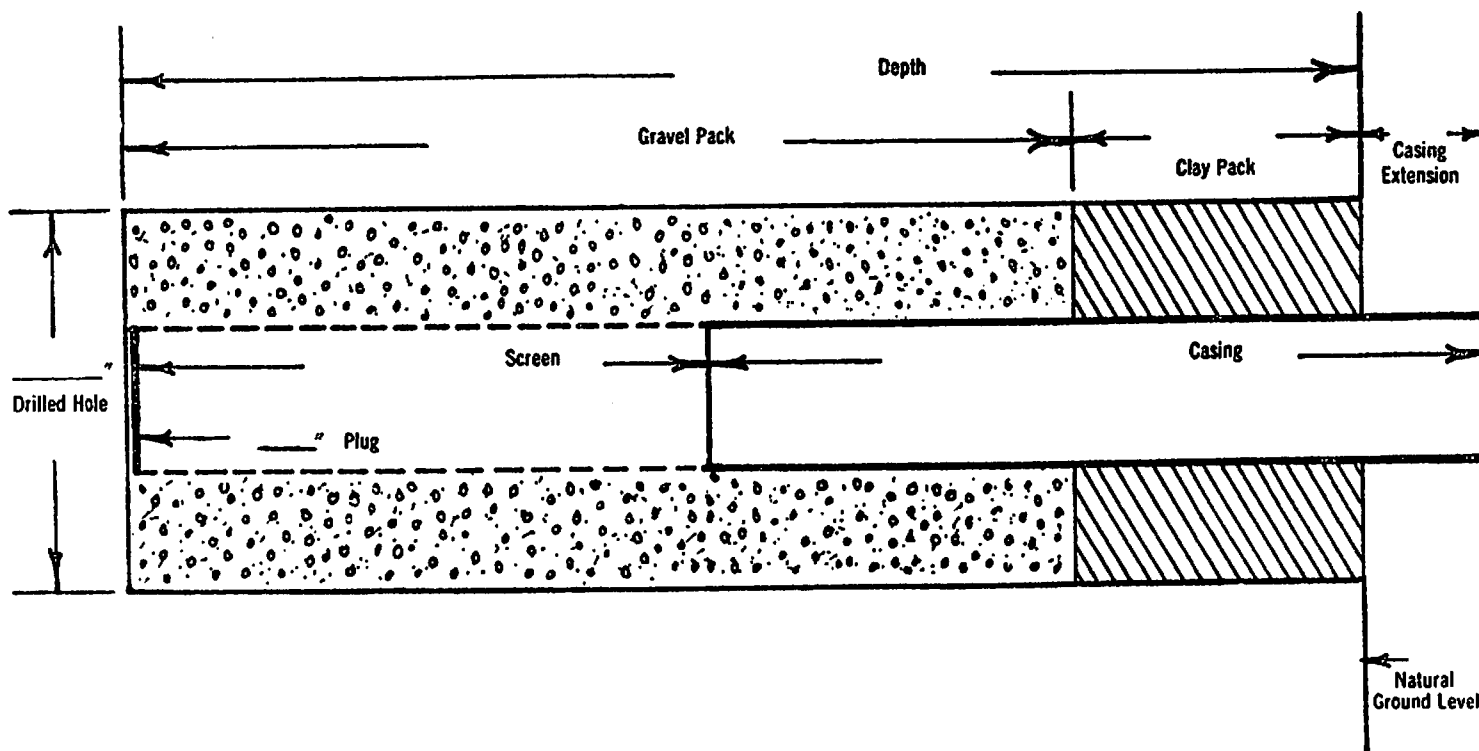

18'	to 10'	Tan loess
10'	to 68'-9"	Light tan clay till w/small boulders, lg. boulders at 57'
68'-9"	to 71'	Coarse brown sand and gravel
71'	to 82'	Yellow glacial clay
82'	to 95'	Light gray glacial clay, large boulders at 84'
95'	to 110'	Gray glacial clay w/many boulders
110'	to 122'	Shaley dark gray clay
122'	to 134'	Yellow galcial clay with boulders
134'	to 143'	Gray glacial clay
143'	to 205'	Blue gray clay till w/boulders
205'	to 315'	Sandy blue gray clay till w/many boulders
315'	to 318'	Coarse gray sand and gravel
318'	to 333'	Dark gray clay till w/large boulders
333'	to 337'	Cemented gray coarse sand and gravel
337'	to 339'	Gray clay

339'	to 354'	Coarse gray sharp sand and gravel w/boulders and thin streaks of clay
354'	to 360'	Coarse gray very sharp sand and gravel
360'	to 369'	Yellow brown loose coarse sand and gravel
369'	to 371'	Fine to coarse yellow brown sand and gravel
371'	to 373'	Fine to coarse gray sand and dirty with black caly and peat.
373'	to 375'	Peat-coal-gray clay and fine gray sand
375'	to 384'	Coal gray clay and fine gray sand
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
