Dear Bruce:

On behalf of the City of Rock Rapids, we are requesting a well site survey for proposed Well No. 8. This will be a drilled well located 175 feet north and approximately 45 feet west of existing Well No. 4. As you may be aware, Well No. 4 is not being used at the present time because of its high iron content. The new proposed well was pumped for 30 hours at 200 gallons per minute with a combined iron and manganese content of less than .1 ppm. The log on this particular hole reads as follows:

1'-4'	Clay
4'-19'	Good gravel
19'-20'	Rock
20'-23'	Good gravel
23'-30'	Sand and blue clay

The test well was constructed to a total depth of 23 feet.

The City is anxious to proceed as rapidly as possible in construction of this new well as demands on the system will be taxed beyond their capabilities to supply without additional sources. If you require any additional information, please call our office or contact the City.
