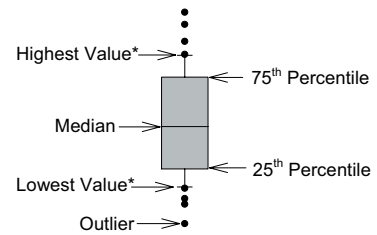
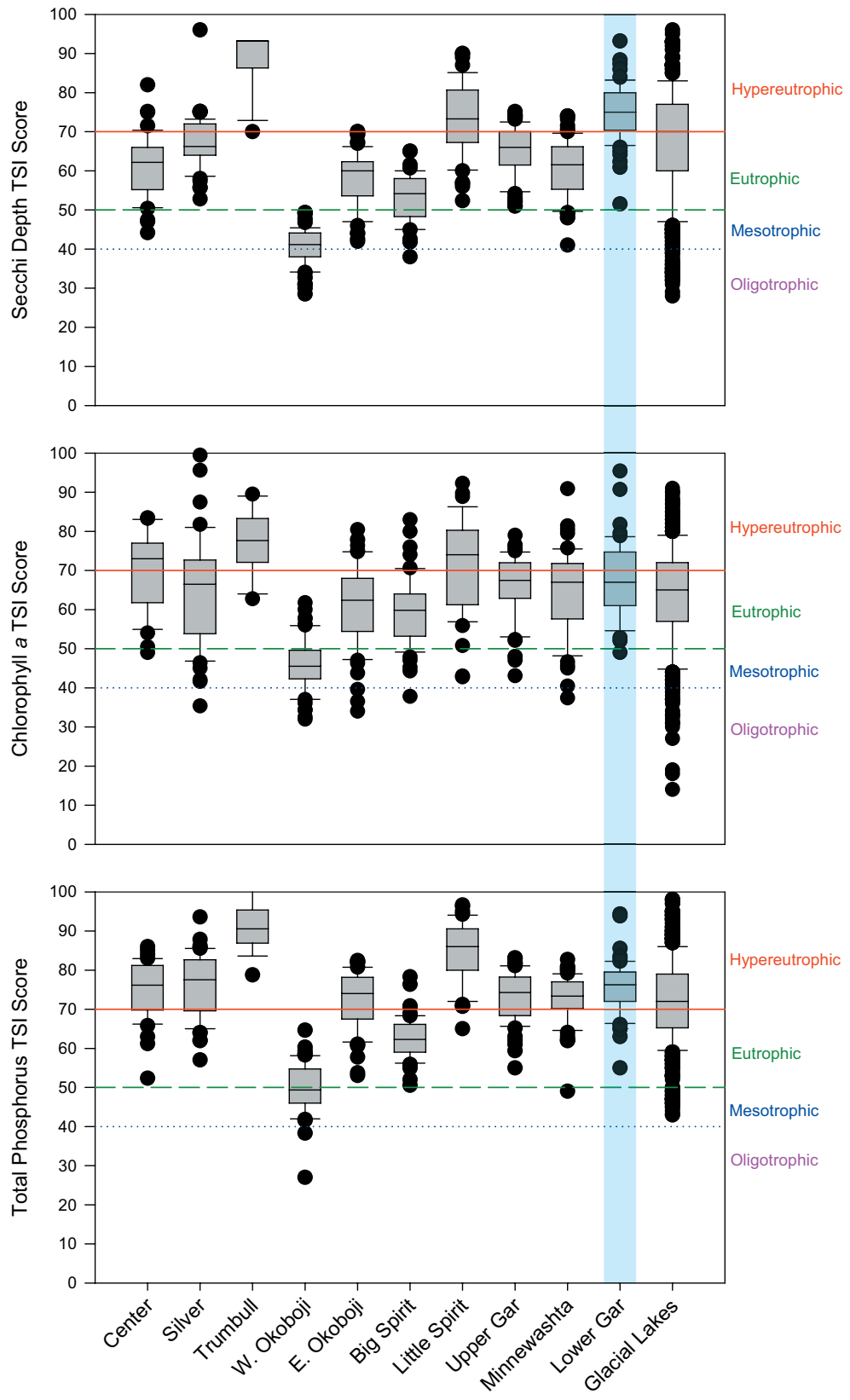


Reading a box plot (right) – The median is the middle value in a group of numbers arranged in increasing order. If the median line is not in the center of the box, then the data are skewed. The length of the box represents the spread of the data (the larger the box, the greater the spread). An outlier is an unusual case.
